\*\*The total number of transfer credits are 6 – 9. Those in year one induction can still be enrolled but will not receive the credit transfer until the clear

credential is complete.

Students can shorten this time to completion average by not taking breaks. GCU's counseling staff will provide all options prior to enrollment.

The rates are effective for the 2019-20 academic year and are subject to change, so register as soon as possible to get these rates.
